At this open house, CSX will provide information about upcoming construction activities near the Virginia Avenue Tunnel, including the general locations where activity will occur, the type of activities and a preliminary schedule.

Information displays detailing construction activities, locations and timelines will be available at the open house. Representatives of CSX and Clark/Parsons, CSX's design-build contractor, will be on hand throughout the event to answer questions.

Information and registration will also be available for the CSX-funded pre-construction inspection program, which is available to construction area neighborhood residents and commercial property owners. Inspections will document the current interior and exterior condition of properties and will help expedite processing of any construction-related claims that may be made in the future.
