

7th Street Closure

Dec. 27, for 1 to 2 weeks

Dear Neighbors:

CSX expects to temporarily close 7th Street SE at the intersection with Virginia Avenue on Tuesday, Dec. 27, 2016. The closure is expected to last for up to 2 weeks. This will allow installation of additional support-of-excavation pilings and other preparations for the transition to the Phase II temporary bridge deck across the area to be excavated for the second new tunnel.

This work is being done now to take advantage of reduced traffic during the year-end holidays, which will limit the impact on area drivers.

While the intersection is closed, detour signs will be in place north and south of Virginia Avenue on 7th Street to direct drivers around the closure. A pathway for pedestrians will remain open while the intersection is closed.

On the following page is an illustration of the detour that will be in place while 7th Street is closed. Signs, barrels, barriers and other traffic control measures will be deployed to guide drivers through the area.

CSX urges all drivers to use caution through this intersection and others affected by the Virginia Avenue Tunnel project. We appreciate the community's patience while we complete this important work.

Detour While 7th Street Is Closed

Dec. 27, for 1 to 2 weeks

Detour signs will direct drivers around the intersection of 7th St. and Virginia Ave:

- Southbound drivers will be directed to turn left on G St., right on 8th St., right on L St. and left on 7th St.
- Northbound drivers will be directed to turn right on L St., left on 8th St., left on I St. and right on 7th St.

Virginia Ave south of the interstate remains closed to traffic.
